Diversity Learning Grant (Other Learning Programmes) 2021/22 Report**

<p>1. “Train Your Brain” English workshop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 8 classes of “Train Your Brain” English workshop were held during September 2021 and August 2022. - The programme content included training on brainstorming, skills building on understand and analyze questions, and practices on tackling questions. - Altogether 127 highly motivated learners of English from S.4 to S.6 attended. - Expenditure: \$51,210 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Students were satisfied with the programme. Responses of the post-workshop survey are as follows: - 88% of the students agreed that the workshops helped them develop their ability to understand and analyze questions. - 81% of the students agreed that their skills in tackling questions were developed. - 85% of the students agreed that the feedbacks from tutors were useful. - 83% of the students were satisfied with the workshop.
<p>2. “Excel to Excellence” Science workshop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 2 classes of “Excel to Excellence” Science workshop were held. 13 lessons were conducted in total. - The programme content included training on logical thinking, skills building on participating in inter-school competitions, and enhancing knowledge in Science. - Altogether 40 highly motivated learners of Science from S.5 to S.6 attended. - Expenditure: \$4,180 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The overall percentage of attendance among students was good. The learning motivation of the students was strong and they showed great capability in understanding Physics concepts. The overall performance was satisfactory. - According to the praises and positive feedback from both the tutors and students, it is highly recommended to re-run this workshop in the coming school year.
<p>3. STEM Training Workshop</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The “STEM Education Committee” organized the AI Maker Workshop for 16 STEM-elite students. - 27 hours of training were conducted in total. - Expenditure: \$48,600 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Most students were satisfied with the programme. 86% of the students agreed that the workshops enhanced their knowledge and interests, and helped them develop their skills in STEM.
